This program has been funded with an initial \$20,000 from the City's General Fund, which would allow for 25 applicants that meet the qualification to receive 1 cordless handheld electrostatic sprayer and 12 32 oz. bottles of disinfectant. Following the first 25 applications, the Council will consider an additional allocation of funds.
