AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AN HONORARY
STREET DESIGNATION

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the CITY OF GENOA, DeKalb County, Illinois, as follows:

WHEREAS, the late Roger Watson had extraordinarily served the community for over 40 years; and

WHEREAS, the Genoa Area Chamber of Commerce has requested that an honorary street designation be placed on a portion of North Monroe Street in memory of Roger Watson; and

WHEREAS, the Genoa Area Chamber of Commerce has followed and understands the regulations under the Honorary Street Designation policy;

NOW THEREFORE be it ordained:

SECTION 1: That an honorary street designation sign be placed on North Monroe Street in memory of Roger Watson, a community member who extraordinarily served the community of Genoa for over 40 years.

SECTION 2: That the regulations set forth in the Honorary Street Designation Policy will be adhered to.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and following its passage and approval.


